## **GS Charity Foundation Donates to Support Victims of Turkey-Syria Earthquake**

On 6th February 2023, a 7.8 magnitude earthquake struck Turkey and Syria, over 7 million people were forced homeless. Thousands of buildings have been reduced to rubble while victims were waiting desperately for rescue. The tragedy shocked people around the globe. Governments from different regions, including China and Hong Kong Special Administrative Region, immediately arranged rescue teams and necessary supplies to Turkey and Syria to help the victims.

With a steadfast will to devote its surplus to society and to achieve greater benefit for all, GS Charity Foundation donated total HKD 10 millions in three times to UNHCR, through their rescue team to provide emergency support to the victims.

With a wholehearted gratitude to Dr. Charles Yeung and GS Charity Foundation, Mr. Vanno Noupech, the UNHCR Representative in China, together with his team visited the Hong Kong Headquarters of Glorious

Sun Group. The senior management of the Group Mr. Peter Teo, Ms. Jennifer Yeung and the Chief Administrator, Mr. Steven Leung joined the meeting. Dr. Charles Yeung expressed his concern over the situation of the disaster area and worried about the food supply for the victims. Mr. Vanno Noupech replied, “Because of the massive number of victims and the continuous Russia-Ukraine war, food supply in the disaster area is a long term concern.” He continued, “Thanks to the enthusiastic donation from private enterprises (compared to the fund of governments and related organizations), the United Nations can support the victims directly, flexibly and quickly.” Mr. Vanno Noupech expressed his gratitude to the trust and support from Glorious Sun Group.

Dr. Charles Yeung said, “The Group established GS Charity Foundation and allocate a certain amount of profit to the Foundation every year.” He encouraged the United Nations to collaborate with more enterprises, leading them to serve the community hence promote public welfare.
